

PUPPY SOCIALISATION GUIDELINES

Make puppy safety a priority



1

WORK WITH YOUR VET

keep your puppy current on all vaccinations Wait a minimum of 2 weeks after the first set of injections before you start a puppy class or take your puppy anywhere.

WORK WITH A TRAINER

pick a puppy class provider that uses disinfectant to clean waste and requires proof of vaccination



3

AVOID UNSAFE AREAS

Until your puppy is fully vaccinated, avoid popular dog walking areas. and places where unknown dogs toilet Stay away from dog parks until your puppy is fully vaccinated and at least 6month old.

DON'T FORCE THE ISSUE

Only let your puppy interact with other dogs that are healthy, friendly and current on vaccinations. Never force your puppy to face something that scares him or makes him react aggressively. Remove him from the situation



5

WATCH YOUR PUPPY

Always keep an eye on your puppy and be ready to remove her from situations that overwhelm her

LEARN TO READ YOUR PUPPY

Practice reading your puppy's body language, especially signs of stress. It is easier than you think and will help you a great deal.
